

# Bill Mertens Memorial Daily Iowan Scholarship

The *Daily Iowan* has awarded more than \$1 million in scholarships since 1987. The program was started to help bring outstanding high school journalists to the University of Iowa and to work in the *DI* newsroom.

## \$2,000 per academic year

- Provided in two equal payments at the beginning of each semester.
- High school seniors entering college in Fall 2019 are eligible.
- Women, minorities and individuals with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

Potential to earn a scholarship renewal on a semester-by-semester basis, for a maximum of four years, provided satisfactory progress has been made in both academic work and in the newsroom.

### Renewal Requirements include:

- Minimum grade-point average of 2.7
- Completion of at least nine credit hours per semester
- Satisfactory newsroom performance, as evaluated by the editor-in-chief, a coach and the publisher

## The Process

Application deadline is January 31, 2019.

Scholarship committee reviews applicants. Finalists will be invited to campus for a visit and interview in late February.

The recipient(s) will be notified on or around March 15, 2019.

The *Daily Iowan* is the independent, nonprofit student newspaper located on the University of Iowa campus. The newsroom is entirely student-run and student-managed.

The *DI* celebrated its 150th anniversary in 2018 as the oldest college newspaper west of the Mississippi River.

Our media properties include:

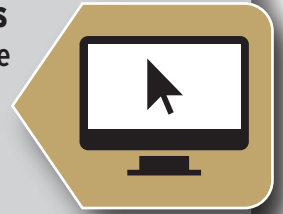
- **The Daily Iowan print newspaper:** published Monday through Friday during the school year and weekly in the summer

- ✓ One-page statement on how working at *The Daily Iowan* will fit into your educational and career goals
- ✓ Three examples of your journalistic work (i.e. writing/reporting, photos, photo slideshow, graphics/design, video)
- ✓ A copy of your high school transcript
