Scholarship Opportunities from The Daily Iowan

The Daily Iowan has awarded more than \$1.2 million in scholarships since 1987. The program was started to help bring outstanding high school journalists to the University of Iowa and to work in the DI newsroom.

\$2,000 a year for up to four years

Bill Mertens Memorial Daily Iowan Scholarship

- Eligibility: High school seniors entering college in Fall 2025
- Renewable on a semester-by-semester basis for a maximum of four years
- Merit-based scholarship

Daily Iowan Newsroom Diversity Scholarship

- Eligibility: High school seniors entering college in Fall 2025
- Renewable on a semester-by-semester basis for a maximum of four years
- Merit-based scholarship; contributing criteria includes students who are from historically underrepresented populations:
 - Alaskan Native, American Indian/Native American, Black/African American, Hispanic, Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, two or more underrepresented races
 - Individuals with disabilities
 - First-generation college students

Renewal requirements for both scholarships include:

- Satisfactory newsroom performance, as evaluated by the executive editor and the publisher
- Completion of at least nine credit hours per semester
- Minimum grade-point average of 2.70

Scholarships are independent of any University of lowa financial aid package and provided in two equal payments at the beginning of each semester.

Application Process

Application deadline is January 31, 2025.

Scholarship committee reviews applications and finalists will be invited for a campus visit/interview in February.

The recipient(s) will be notified in March.

The Daily lowan is the independent, nonprofit student newspaper located on the University of lowa campus. The newsroom is entirely student-run and student-managed.

The *DI* earned several top awards in 2024, including three Pacemaker awards from the Associated Collegiate Press – Newspaper, Online and Multimedia (the third year in a row!). The nine Pacemaker awards won by the *DI* in the last three years are more than any college news organization in the country.

- One-page statement on how working at *The Daily Iowan* will fit into your educational and career goals
- Three examples of your journalistic work (i.e. writing/reporting, photos, photo slideshow, graphics/design, video)
- ✓ A copy of your high school transcript
